Tereos optimises its industrial footprint in Brazil by divesting one of its six production sites

In order to strengthen its competitiveness, Tereos announces its intention to divest one of its Brazilian plant in Andrade (Ribeirão Preto Region). This operation would enable Tereos to reorganise its sugarcane activities in Brazil around 5 plants, allowing for better industrial, agricultural and logistical optimisation as well as the strengthening of its capital structure.

The divestment of the Andrade plant, together with 2 million tonnes of sugarcane, to the company VIRALCOOL would contribute to the optimisation of Tereos' agricultural and industrial footprint in Brazil. This geographical reorganisation would enable greater performance of our operations and strengthens Tereos locally to pursue its long-term strategy.

It also illustrates the active and rigorous management of the cooperative Group's asset portfolio as a whole.

Tereos has been present in Brazil for over 25 years and is the second-largest Brazilian sugar producer. This activity, which represented 40% of the Group's consolidated EBITDA for the 2024/2025 financial year, is one of the strategic pillars of its diversification.

The completion of the transaction, which would result in the transfer of the Andrade unit to the acquiring company and the divestment of 2 million tonnes of sugarcane, is subject to approval by the Brazilian Administrative Council for Economic Defence (CADE). No final decision will be made until this process has been completed, in accordance with legal requirements.
